Preparing your article

Your article should provide a new and refreshing perspective on a problem or event and cannot already have been published on other websites.

Please structure your article as well as possible. Try to think of the angle of your story, and to specify the questions that you will attempt to answer throughout the article. One way to do this is to make a mind map of all information you gathered before you start writing.

After submission, we will work with you to edit the article and prepare it for publication. You will have a say in this process. Once your article is published, we will include an author box featuring your name, picture and a short biography. Once your article is finished, it will be published on our website and promoted via social media and newsletters.

Some pointers

- Please use British English spelling and style.
- We aim to write articles that are substantial in content, but easy to read. Please use words that you would use in a normal conversation and try to keep your sentences short. Only 25% of sentences should contain more than 20 words.
- Paragraphs should be 150 words or less.
- Use subheadings
- Please also think of a title and introduction for your article.
